Tuition Policy

TUITION POLICY DETAILS

- Payment of tuition is DUE BY THE 1ST OF THE MONTH. Payment of tuition secures enrollment for your child in class.
- If your child is absent due to any reason; illness, vacation, other activities, payment is STILL due by the 1st to continue to hold the spot for your child.
- If not available to pay in person please contact the front desk with a credit card for your tuition by the 7th of the month to avoid late fees (See policy on late fees).
- We offer automatic credit card deductions for monthly tuition. We accept Visa and MasterCard. A Credit Card Authorization Form will need to be completed and signed to take advantage of this automatic deduction. April and the Recital Fee as well as May and June tuition will be charged together on April 1st May 1st accordingly.
- The custodial parent is responsible for payments.
- If your child is no longer taking classes, a "Drop" form must be completed or notification in writing is required. Any outstanding fees on the account must be paid in full upon unenrollment.
- If student has not been in class for five weeks, we will assume that the child has dropped.
- The re-enrollment fee within the season is \$25.

Our season currently is scheduled to start Tuesday, September 8th, 2020 through June 12th, 2021.

- TUITION REMAINS THE SAME EACH MONTH REGARDLESS OF WHETHER IT IS A 5-WEEK MONTH OR A SHORTENED MONTH DUE TO HOLIDAYS. <u>Tuition is not pro-rated, refunded or credited for missed classes or holidays</u>. Any student who misses a class may make-up classes in other comparable classes within the same month. Please pick-up the form at the front office for make-up classes, prior to taking the class. This will let the teacher know of the make-up.
- So that we can close out for the season and get ready for recital, full tuition for the months of <u>May and June are collected together on May 1st</u>. In June, the technical rehearsal, dress rehearsal and the recital are charged as one class each as the teachers are required to be there and must be paid for their time.

Late Fees

- Payments are due the 1st of each month! Payments received after the 10th of the month will be assessed a \$25 Late Fee unless we have received a "Drop" form or written notification dropping the child from class prior to the 10th of the month. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- A \$35 return check fee will be added on all insufficient fund checks.



Registration & Fees

How to Register

- Read Policies & Procedures thoroughly, consult the Fall 2020-2021 Schedule of Classes and determine which class or program you are interested in registering your child for. Call our office with any questions at 480-661-7461.
- Fully complete the Student Registration/Emergency Form in its entirety. This form must be signed and dated by a parent or guardian. (These forms are also available to download from our website in pdf format.)
- Mail completed forms, along with an annual \$35.00 nonrefundable Registration Fee (per student) payable to Plumb Performing Arts Center, 9153 E. Bell Rd, Scottsdale, AZ 85260.
- You may also bring completed forms to PPAC during our Fall Registration Week from Mon August 17th through Saturday August 22ndst. We advise early registration during these days as some classes fill up quickly.
- First day of Fall Classes is Tuesday, September 8th, 2020. Late sign-ups will be taken throughout the Fall of 2020 depending on class availability.

Placement

Parents of all Pre-Primary, Primary and Beginning students can easily and quickly choose a class (designated as such) from our 2020-2021 schedule. If you are a new intermediate or advanced level student we will need to see you for a placement class or for advisement from the director or a teacher. We will have staff available during Registration Week to help with placement questions.

Placement also occurs during class time in August and September. Any recommended level changes teachers deem necessary will be discussed with both parent and child after the first 3 to 4 weeks of classes.

Fees

Registration Fees:

Registration fees are **\$35.00** per student, per year and are non-refundable. This fee is payable upon registration.

Monthly Tuition Fees:

Monthly Tuition Fees are <u>DUE ON THE FIRST OF THE MONTH</u>. MONTHLY FEES REMAIN THE SAME REGARDLESS OF THE NUMBER OF LESSONS TAUGHT WITHIN A MONTH DUE TO HOLIDAYS OR REGARDLESS OF CHILD'S ABSENCES. SEE TUITION POLICY FOR DETAILS.

Our season is August 17th, 2020 through June 12, 2021, ending with the recital. See Calendar for dates.

LATE FEES/RETURNED CHECK FEES:

A late fee of \$25 will be assessed for payments received after the 10th of the month – NO EXCEPTIONS. A \$35 return check fee will be added onto all insufficient fund checks. There are no refunds for missed classes.

Accepted Forms of Payment:

We accept Visa and MasterCard, debit, checks and cash. If you are paying by check, please be sure to note the month and the child's name in the memo area. You are responsible for receipts of cash payments!

Some classes/rehearsals will be paid separately and directly to the instructor. Check with the front desk!

May & June Tuition fees will be due together on May 1st 2021 (normal monthly amounts) due to closing out accounts prior to recital. The technical rehearsal, dress rehearsal and the recital are charged as one class each in June as the teachers are there and must be paid for their time.

Recital Fees:

A "Recital Fee" of \$160.00 per family is due April 1, 2021, applicable if your child(ren) are participating in the annual June Recital. This fee covers the auditorium rental and other associated costs. You will receive 10 recital tickets in June once all dance fees are paid. The number of tickets issued is per family rather than per show. Additional tickets may be purchased.

Costume Fees:

Every student participating in the annual June Recital must purchase a costume. All fees for costumes will be due in full by December 15th. Costumes are ordered in December; therefore, parents and students must decide by November if they are going to participate in the recital. Costumes for single subject classes are \$85 a piece. Costumes for double subject classes are \$170 for both. Costume Fees are non-refundable once costumes are ordered. Late fees will be charged if payments are received after December 15th. Any costume ordered in January will be charged an additional \$10 fee. Cut-off for costume orders is January 31st. No Exceptions.

Company Dancers:

Students participating in PPAC Company (competition) programs must pay a non-refundable Commitment/Administrative Annual Fee of \$300.00 by Sept 1, 2020.

Discounts:

- Family Discounts: (Off of the Monthly Tuition Only) Applies to immediate family members under the same custodial parent. Families may take \$5.00 off of the total monthly bill for a second child enrolled; \$5.00 off of the third child enrolled; and \$5.00 off per month for the fourth child enrolled in PPAC classes. No discounts apply to Friday Company classes or Valley Youth Theater satellite program classes.
- Company Discounts: (Applies to Unlimited Company Dancers Only). Families with two or more Unlimited Company Dancers may take \$30.00 off of the total monthly bill for each additional Unlimited Dancer.
